It has been a challenging year due to the still unfinished front gate landscaping and irrigation system. Many of our plans have been on hold until this major project is completed.

The decision regarding prospective areas to be gardened by the club has been tabled until front gate landscaping is completed by David Guidry.

- 5. Designs will be judged by the Flag Design Committee which consists of: Kathy Crouchet, Paulette Hecker, and Ceanne Hirstius representing the Garden Club. Joan Bayard, Geary Hirstius, and Don Hotard will represent the Civic Association. Sandy Miller will be chairing the joint committee and will vote only in the case of a tie.

6. Winner's award to be determined.

Kathy Hymel gave an update on the small fountain. The slab will be poured as soon as weather permits, and the fountain for the median in front of the guard house should be in place within the next two weeks. Progress!

The "Wow Wall" is on hold until the front landscaping is complete, and is pending upon David Guidry's written permission to proceed, and the HOA board approval. Time will tell.
