

Notice of resignation to the LRHOA Members

I am resigning from the Lake Ramsey Home Owners Board of Directors with immediate effect. This has been a very difficult decision for me because I have enjoyed serving the residents over the past 3 ½ years.

Unfortunately, there has been a number of factors of late which has resulted in this decision.

1. The continual unsubstantiated threats of law suits against board members by residents.
2. The continual unsubstantiated allegations of board members being corrupt either by taking “kickbacks” or acting with vengeance against residents.
