This is caused by the brick and mortar storm drain basin- we replaced the top half 18 months ago and will likely either have to replace the bottom half or install a concrete sleeve inside of it to prevent it from failing. The Mortar is failing and causing the basin to wash out. We also inspected the sink hole next to Gary Forbes' property. We replaced the rear 40' of drainage pipe and this looks to be another section
